2012 Spring Soccer Registration

Online registration now available

REGISTRATION: The Hopewell Valley Soccer Association (HVSA) is now accepting registrations for the spring 2012 season. Registration and payment must be done using our online registration system which can be found on our website at <http://www.hvsasoccer.org>

PROGRAMS: There are four different age divisions for the spring season. Divisions are split by gender and age, with the exception of the oldest division, which is coed. Children age 6 to 18 (as of August 1, 2011) are eligible to participate. **REGISTRATIONS PRIOR TO March 28, 2012 will be guaranteed placement on a team. Waitlists are possible for registrations after this date.**

Age determines what program a player can register for. **Age is determined by age on August 1, 2011.** Programs are grouped by age. HVSA allows a player to play in a program above his/her age group if the player is no more than one year younger than the bottom age of the next program.

JOSHUA RIGEL SCHOLARSHIP FUND: Families experiencing financial hardships may request aid from the JOSHUA RIGEL SCHOLARSHIP FUND. An application may be downloaded from the HVSA web site.

SCHEDULE NOTES: Games are played on Sunday afternoons beginning on April 15, 2012 and continuing for 8 weeks. Games will not be played on the Memorial Day holiday weekend in May. There are no practices. The last set of games will be June 10. Weather cancellation will be made up June 17.

A schedule will be provided after teams are formed. Locations are not finalized, but we will try to keep the same locations. The locations used last year are listed above. (Independence Park is by Stony Brook Elementary.)

EQUIPMENT NOTES: Shin guards are mandatory in all Divisions. Shirts only will be provided. Proper gym shorts, socks and footwear are the responsibility of the players.
